HOW Class presentations were provided as follows:



Rich Gaughan will teach basic bowl turning. He described his love of turning bowls and brought in a few samples of his work.





Jim Hobson will teach the making of finials and temblors. He will discuss proportion, set up and execution of these.



Carol Leader will teach how to pour your own acrylics. She showed some 3/4" diameter pours and a dixie cup pour of the scraps which was turned into a bottle stopper.



Scott Malin will teach the use of Sketchup to create 2-D and 3-D models and drawings.






Phil Hauser's courses are "Turning a Natural Edge Bowl" and "Turning a Lidded Box". He brought samples of a natural edge bowl, and two lidded boxes including this one of Macassar Ebony. He will also teach Hybrid Blanks with Dave Potts.



Dave Potts will teach "How to create a Hybrid Turning Blank" with Phil, and also "Turning a Three Sided Lidded Box", and "Laser Engraving on Woodturnings". He brought samples of the three sided boxes and the hybrid blanks. Everyone who has a name tag has a sample of the laser engraving.





Marty Richter is teaching two courses, "Multi-Axis and Spindle Turning", and "You and the Skew". He brought samples of a multi axis candle holder and a letter opener made with a skew.




Dave Leader will teach a course on making functional objects such as Pens, Fan Pulls, Bottle Stoppers, etc. He brought in a box filled with all types of turnings that he makes.





Ray Cole will teach the basics of Segmented Turning. He brought in quite a few samples and described some of the tools that can be used to produce segments.



Jim Parise will teach coring with a McNaughton Bowl Saver. Jim said that he can regularly get up to four bowls from a blank now that he has gotten the hang of the system.





Doug James will teach two courses, "Threaded Box" and "Urn". Doug demonstrated the threading system at our Mini How in January.
